Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s):

At their meeting on September 22, 2009, the Board of Education approved a motion for procedural options should the school district need to make up a large number of lost school days. These options would only apply if the school district needs to close for an extended time period because of an event like a major Swine Flu outbreak. I am providing this information to you, at this point in time, so that you may factor it into any relevant family plans. The options are:

- A. Days will be added to the end of the school year up until the last day of June.
- B. If additional days beyond option A are needed and we are aware of this fact prior to December 1st, the district will be in session between December 28th and December 31st.
- C. If additional days are needed beyond option A and we are aware of this fact after December 1st, the district will be in session between April 5th and April 8th.
- D. If additional days are required beyond the number accounted for in the above scenarios, the district will be in session on Saturdays beginning in May.

Currently the Policy Committee of the Board of Education is considering how the implementation of any of these scenarios will impact on the Board's attendance policy. Once a decision has been reached on this issue, further communication will be forthcoming. Please contact me if you have any questions on this matter.
